Kristin M. Kilbourn, PhD, MPH, is Associate Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of Colorado Denver (CU Denver). She is also Associate Member of the University of Colorado Comprehensive Cancer Center and holds an adjunct faculty position in the Department of Internal Medicine and a clinical faculty position in the Department of Psychiatry on the CU Denver Medical Campus. Dr. Kilbourn earned her MPH in Health Promotion at San Diego State University in California, followed by a PhD in Clinical Health Psychology at the University of Miami in Coral Gables, Florida. She completed her clinical internship at the Bruce W. Carter Veterans Administration Medical Center in Miami, Florida.

Dr. Kilbourn has authored numerous articles for professional journals, including the *Journal of the National Cancer Institute* and the *Journal of Psychosocial Oncology*, and has presented her research at several national and international meetings and conferences. She mentors doctoral students at CU Denver, where she has an active research lab. Dr. Kilbourn is a member of multiple professional organizations, including the International Society of Behavioral Medicine, the American Psychosomatic Society, and the American Psychosocial Oncology Society, and she serves as a peer reviewer for the American Cancer Society. Her research has been funded by the National Cancer Institute, the American Cancer Society, and the **LIVESTRONG** Foundation, and she is currently involved in several research projects relating to psychosocial oncology, cancer survivorship (patient and family issues), and palliative care.
